- 3. Discuss the main differences between derivational morphology and inflectional morphology. Please use examples from English and Chinese to illustrate your answer. (15 points)
- 4. Examples (i) to (vii) demonstrate the action of a phonological rule found in some children's dialect that is not found in the adult norm.
