This listening comprehension test will test your ability to understand spoken English. In this test, each conversation, short talk and question will be spoken JUST ONE TIME. They will not be written out for you. There are three parts to this test. Special instructions will be given to you at the beginning of each part.

## Part A

In part A, you will hear 15 questions. After you hear a question, read the four choices in your test book and decide which one is the best answer to the question you have heard.

Example:

You will hear: Mae wasn't in class today!

You will read:

- A. What's the matter with you?
- B. No, I don't have any information from her.
- C. Yes, I wonder whether she is sick or not.
- D. Mind your own business.

The best answer to the question "Mae wasn't in class today!" is C: "Yes, I wonder whether she is sick or not." Therefore, you should choose answer C.

Question: What does the man mean?

- You will read: A. He agrees that the woman makes many mistakes.  
B. He suggests the woman ask a tutor.  
C. He suggests that the woman practice more.  
D. He thinks that grammar is not so important.

The best answer to the question "What does the man mean?" is C: "He suggests that the woman practice more." Therefore, you should choose answer C.

They also move their tails up and down when they swim, while fish move theirs from side to side. Most fish lay eggs, but whales give birth to live babies, and care for them for a whole year. Whales take in air through blowholes near the tops of their heads. Whales have to think about every breath they take. This means that whales do not really fall asleep. If they did, they would drown!

Question number 1: What is the similarity between whales and fish?

- You will read: A. The way they breathe.  
 B. Their appearance.  
 C. The way they move..  
 D. They are cold-blooded.

The best answer to the question " What is the similarity between whales and fish? " is B: "Their appearance. " Therefore, you should choose answer B.
