A cancer-causing factor in our environment is the light of the sun. The ultraviolet radiation story began in Germany in 1894, when scientists expressed their belief that too much exposure to sunlight was related to skin cancer. In 1928, English scientists succeeded in producing skin cancer in experimental animals exposed to bright sunlight.

The cancer-producing effects of the ultraviolet rays of sunlight seem to be limited to the skin. It has been noticed that the incidence of skin cancer is the highest in the southern and western parts of the United Stated and lowest in the North. Furthermore, skin cancer occurs more often among people who work outdoors, such as sailors and farmers, than among people who can guard themselves against too much exposure to the sun.

The color of the skin is another factor. Cancer of the skin is most common among fair-skinned people. It is much less common among Black and others with dark skin.

Related to the cancer-causing effects of sunlight is the discovery of the dangers of ionizing radiation from radium and X-rays. This discovery was actually made on human beings. Early radiologists developed dryness, ulcers and eventually, cancer of their hands.
