But in the wake of Taiwan's widening food scandal, Chinese and Taiwanese-Americans living in New York, home to the largest overseas Chinese population in the US, say they are thinking twice about that they put in their carts..." (Taipei Time, 2013). In 2014, even more food safety scandals and unethical wastewater incidents were found in Taiwan.
