(B) "I have learned a great deal from listening carefully. Most people never listen," Ernest Hemingway said, and he was right. We give importance to speaking our minds but often forget the value of listening.

We "hear" things, but they may go in one ear and out the other. Listening, __6__, requires attention and concentration. It's the ability to receive messages accurately. Because misunderstandings happen when people don't listen carefully, listening, __7__ talking, is the key to effective communication.

How do we become better listeners? First, show respect. Don't __8__ the speaker, and keep an open mind even if you disagree with the speaker's views. Second, try to talk less than you listen. Though it may take practice, control your __9__ to frequently weigh in, and speak only when the moments seem right.

When those right moments might be depends on the conversation. In general, good listeners don't jump in with their opinions or advice. __10__, they might ask questions that draw information from the speaker. This information may then help the speaker recognize problems and solutions.

(C) Polar bears are among the most recognizable animals on Earth. They are known for their broad shoulders, large paws, and white fur, __11__ the impression of huge stuffed animals. These enormous beasts are only cute from a distance, though. In fact, they are the world's largest land __12__, and have been known to eat humans. A full grown male can be between 350 and 500 kilograms, with females generally being half that size. Though they will eat virtually anything, most of their diet consists of seals. They often catch seals as the latter come up for air or to take a rest. Polar bears are also strong swimmers, a skill they use to travel between large packs of floating ice or hunt for food.

Polar bears are well adapted to their cold __13__. Their fur is warm and waterproof, their bodies have a thick layer of blubber, and even the shape of their head and neck protects them from the cold. A small head results in giving off less heat, and a long neck gives the cold Arctic air a chance to warm up before hitting the bear's lungs.
