Anorexia and bulimia which are nervous disorders characterized by extreme eating attitudes and distorted body image are among the most deadly psychiatric disorders and do not have yet proven effective treatments.

A baseline study conducted by the psychiatric medical faculty of San Diego in California suggests that a function in the damaged brain circuits called neural circuits is the cause of poor appetite in anorexic and too full of appetite in bulimic. This research published online in the Journal of the American Psychiatry, may be able to offer new avenues of research to find better treatments for these serious eating disorders.

It was still unknown whether people with anorexia or bulimia suffer from disturbances in the nervous system that controls appetite in the brain, or dietary attitudes were conducted by other phenomena, such as the obsession of body image. Nevertheless, this study establishes, as those made earlier that there is a link between these disorders and neuronal processes in the insula, a part of the brain where the taste is felt and integrated with the feeling of reward and helps whether an individual is still hungry or full.

It would therefore be possible to eventually qualify the experience of hunger, for example, increase the activity of the insula to individuals with anorexia and reduce exaggerated responses or unstable compared to food for those who suffer from bulimia. For example, drugs could be developed that would increase the feeling of reward or otherwise inhibit food intake directly into the neural circuits of the brain.
