The cultural status of tattooing has steadily evolved from that of an anti-social activity in the 1960s to that of a socially acceptable fashion statement today. First adopted and flaunted by influential rock stars like the Rolling Stones in the early 1970s, tattooing had, by the late 1980s, become accepted by ever-broader segments of mainstream society. Today, tattoos are routinely seen on rock musicians, sports stars and other public figures who play a significant role in setting the culture's behavior patterns.

The market demographics for tattoo services are now skewed heavily toward mainstream customers. Tattooing today is the sixth fastest-growing retail business in the United States. The single fastest-growing demographic group seeking tattoo services is, to the surprise of many, middle-class suburban women. The state and local governments of New Jersey, like those of other regions across the United States, are being forced to alter their attitude and laws in response to the changing cultural status and popularity of tattooing and have now adopted a more open-minded approach to tattoos.
