- 1. Choose ONE play by Shakespeare and discuss the functions of the play's supernatural elements and how they contribute to the plotting of the story.
- 2. The first twenty-six lines of Book I of Milton's *Paradise Lost* introduce the theme of the poem, "man's first disobedience, and the fruit/Of that forbidden tree, whose mortal taste/Brought death into the world..." (1-3)—and contain a number of intriguing statements. Milton claims to be pursuing "things unattempted yet in prose or rhyme" (16) which can be taken to mean an enterprise unprecedented in non-literary or literary writing. What do you think it is? Please elaborate your view in details.
