Republican economists were 1. Saturday that President-elect Donald Trump's economic policies could get the economy growing closer to a sustainable 3% annual rate, but the suggestion was greeted with 2. by a senior member President Obama's economic team.

At the moment, the Congressional Budget Office estimates the economy's sustainable growth rate is 1.8%, down from a 3. rate above 3%.

During a bipartisan panel discussion at the American Economic Association meeting, Glenn Hubbard, dean of the Columbia University Business School, said Trump's plans could get GDP growth "up to 2.75% or so."

While the details of Trump's policies remain unknown, the combination of broad-based tax reform, regulatory reform, infrastructure and military spending could 4. the economy, Hubbard said.

However, Jason Furman, Obama's chief economist, shot back that Republicans were 5. the "massive" depressing impact on growth from an aging workforce.

"This is going to 6. a lot. If you forecast something like 2%-2.2% [growth], it is going to take your budget in one direction, if you forecast 2.75% or higher, it is going to take your budget in a different direction, he said.

Furman said of growth rates of 2.75% or higher would be further away from the forecast of 7. economists "than any budget... in the last 24 years."

"Part of how you get higher is 8. thinking," Furman said. Details of any tax cut will matter, he said.

Japanese car giant Toyota says will invest \$10bn (£8.2bn) in the US over the next five years - the latest car giant to 11. major investments. The firm's North America chief executive, Jim Lentz, announced the decision at the Detroit motor show. He said it had nothing to do with President-elect Donald Trump's 12. to imported cars, but was part of its existing strategy.

Mr Lentz said the money was going on a new headquarters in Texas and upgrades to existing US car plants.

Last week, Mr Trump 14. General Motors for building cars in Mexico for the US market.

"General Motors is sending Mexican-made model of Chevy Cruze to US car dealers tax-free across border. Make in USA or pay big border tax!" he tweeted.

He also threatened Toyota with a border tax if it went 15. with a new plant in Mexico.

On Monday, Mr Lentz said Toyota had been planning for the Mexico plant for at least two years before announcing the move in 2015 and that it was a long-term decision.

Sterling fell about 1% across the board. The only currency against which it gained ground was the Turkish lira.

The Prime Minister Theresa May told Sky News on Sunday that she wanted the best possible deal for leaving the EU.

However, she 16. the idea that the UK could "keep bits of membership".

She added: "We're leaving. We're coming out. We're not going to be a member of the EU any longer."

Commentators interpreted this as meaning that Mrs May would not seek to keep the UK in the EU's single market, with radical 17. for the country's economy.

By Monday evening, the pound was down 1.05% against the dollar at \$1.2155, while against the euro, it was 1.41% lower at €1.1501.

"Sterling is on the back foot on Monday after Theresa May's comments were taken as a sign the UK government would 18. immigration controls over single market access," said Neil Wilson, senior market analyst at ETX Capital.

"Domestic populist politics 19. the trade card for now, it seems, and that is weighing on the pound."

Mr Wilson predicted "more volatility" in the sterling exchange rate, adding that it could easily "20. back" as the tone of political discourse shifted.

HSBC currency strategist Dominic Bunning agreed: "[Mrs] May saying that it's not about keeping 'bits' of the EU suggests it's not going to be about keeping access to the single market.

"She said we will have full control of our borders, and given what the other side of the 21. - the EU - has said, that's not compatible with full access to the single market, free movement of capital, free movement of goods and services.

"That's the direct trade-off that the [foreign exchange] market is looking at."

The fact that the president-elect Donald Trump received a phone call from President of Taiwan, Tsai Ing-Wen, signalled a dramatic change in U.S.-Taiwan diplomatic scene.
