The proposed settlement relates to a civil lawsuit filed against <u>AIG</u> in mid-2009 by two firms, <u>Safeco Insurance Co. of America</u> (美國 Safeco 保險公司) and <u>Ohio Casualty Insurance Co.</u> (俄亥俄意外事故保險公司) on behalf of a group of insurance companies.
