III. Summary Writing: Read the following passage and summarize it in about 100 words. 25%

John Steinbeck's famous novel, *The Grapes of Wrath*, told of the migration of thousands of poor farmers and their families from the Dust Bowl of Oklahoma to a greener and wealthier California in the Great Depression of the 1930s. The dust-bowl conditions affected huge tracts of prairie land, turning once productive farms into vast desert-like regions.

Poor farming practices, coupled with years of poor rainfall, led to the creation of the American Dust Bowl. These causes are unfortunate but understandable. However, a new phenomenon has been recognized — one that is causing major dust problems around the world. It appears to be the result of the so-called "four-wheel-drive epidemic," or as one professor of geography at Oxford University recently named it, "Toyotarization."

The growth in popularity of off-road vehicles is blamed for not only causing major traffic problems in our cities but also throwing vast quantities of fine dust into the atmosphere. As the off-road crowds tear up the arid regions in various locations, they break the surface rust, liberating fine particles into the atmosphere. The dust, estimated to be in the region of 3 billion tones, swirls around the earth for thousands of kilometers and is responsible for creating dust storms across four continents. The trend is continuing to grow.

In many countries, adverse effects are being felt in health, agriculture and lifestyle. Some of the poorest regions in Africa are the most severely troubled, but evidence of the dust problem is to be found in the United States, China and the Middle East.

It seems that unless strong government action is taken quite soon, there will be an increase in the severity of the dust problem that is already plaguing many parts of the world.
