Write an essay responding to the following viewpoint using two literary texts by different American authors. The essay should include an introductory paragraph with a thesis statement, two to three body paragraphs for analysis and discussion, and a concluding paragraph that restates your position. At least one of the literary texts discussed should be from the 19th century.

American writers and preachers converted the dread of failure into a mode of rhetoric, based on an ambiguity that denied divisiveness between the sacred and the profane, that allowed middle-class consensus to flourish and a patriotic ideology to succeed. A particular formal pattern, in other words, allowed the very exposure of social flaws to become part of a ritual of socialization that informed the transcendent symbol of America.
