1. Please describe the appropriate management strategies for tooth avulsion in primary dentition, young permanent teeth with open apices, and permanent teeth with closed apices. (25%)
2. Please briefly describe the possible sequelae that may occur in the permanent succedaneous teeth following trauma to primary teeth. (10%)
3. Describe the pulp therapy procedures for primary teeth as defined by the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry (AAPD). Your answer should include the definition of each procedure, its indications—based on patient history, clinical findings, and radiographic assessment—its contraindications, and a brief description of the clinical technique. (30%)
4. A mother brings her 6- to 7-month-old infant to a pediatric dentist. The infant has already erupted two mandibular incisors. After an oral examination, the dentist finds that the infant's current oral health status is normal. What anticipatory guidance should the pediatric dentist provide to the mother regarding the infant's oral health? Please list briefly. (10%)
5. (a) Please outline and briefly describe **Wright's Clinical Classification of Child Behavior** and the **Frankl Behavior Rating Scale**.
(b) Based on these classifications, how would you classify a 5-year-old healthy child who is crying, screaming, and refusing to sit in the dental chair? (15%)
6. What factors related to children's growth and development influence their psychology and behavior in the dental clinic? (10%)
