- 1. Discuss the important features of the so-called "Puritan writers" during the colonial period in American Literature and name some as your examples.
- 2. What can be the possible connection between the Bible and the study of American Literature according to your knowledge?
- 3. Identify the author and the title of the work from which the following passage is taken:

Thus the old gentleman ended his harangue. The people heard it, and approved the doctrine, and immediately practiced the contrary, just as if it had been a common sermon; for the vendue opened, and they began to buy extravagantly, notwithstanding all his cautions, and their own fear of taxes.

- 4. What does so-called "American Transcendentalism" stand for? What might be its importance concerning the study of American Literature?
- 5. What does so-called "American Renaissance" stand for? Name some writers taken as the representative writers for it!
- 6. Show your knowledge of the development of American Literature from the very beginning to the nineteenth century!

Please answer **ONE** out of the following questions by writing the answer as a "multiple-paragraph" composition with an introductory section, body section and concluding section from 250 to 300 words.

- 1. Discuss the important features in Ralph Waldo Emerson's *Nature* first and then show the importance of them in studying American Literature during the nineteenth century!
- 2. Discuss the connection between Henry David Thoreau's *Walden* and the so-called "Nature Writing" in the west world!
- 3. Take some episodes from Washington Irving's *Rip van Winkle* to discuss the important issue regarding one's problem of having an identity in life throughout the story!
- 4. Explain any Feminist criticism you know first and take some works written by woman writers in American Literature as examples to explain your point(s) more clearly!
