Passage 2

Faking photographs is frequently used for hoaxes and for political propaganda. Digital images make production of photographic falsehoods quicker and easier. The explosive proliferation of digital-imaging technology makes the question of how to distinguish visual fact from fiction increasingly urgent. Close inspection of traditional photomontages often reveals clear physical evidence of falsehoods, including sharp edges, grainy textures, or mismatching colors. But digital images show far fewer traces, taking less time or craftsmanship. Software offers effective tools for tracing and blending edges, matching tones and replicating textures. Nevertheless, the veracity of a digital image can rest upon internal inconsistencies being carefully cross-checked. In general, the more information there is in an image, the more difficult it is to change without introducing detectable inconsistencies. The provenance of the picture also helps to reject the image as a visual falsehood. Because a photograph is exposed at a specific time and place, we can always ask to hear the story of how the photographer came to be at that very spot at that exact moment. Finally, the subtlest challenge is posed by images that show no detectable signs and yet contradict our established beliefs. Such intellectual judgments will be our increasingly crucial confidence in a world where convincing visual evidence can be faked with ease.
