The conservatism of the early English colonists in North America, their strong attachment to the English way of doing things, would play a major part in the furniture that was made in New England. The very tools that the first New English furniture makers used were, after all, not much different from those used for centuries-even millennia; basic hammers, saws, chisels, planes, augers, compass, and measures. These were the tools used more or less by all people who worked with wood: carpenter, barrel makers, and shipwrights. At most the furniture makers might have had planes with special edges or more delicate chisels, but there could not have been much specialization in the early years of the colonies.

Relatively little hardware was used during this period. Same nails forged by hand were used, but no screws or glue. Hinges were often made of leather, but metal hinges were also used. The cruder varieties were made by blacksmiths in the colonies, but the finer metal elements were imported. Above all, what the early English colonists imported was their knowledge of, familiarity with, and dedication to the traditional types and designs of furniture they knew in England.
