III. English-Chinese Translation: Please translate the following paragraph into Chinese. (20%)

Morton (1969) proposed that each word that an individual knows has a neural representation in long-term memory. He uses the term "logogen" to describe this representation. Each logogen has a 'testing level' of activity, a level which can be increased by contextual information in the input. When a logogen reaches a 'threshold', it 'fires', and the word is 'recognised'. The threshold is a function of word frequency: more frequent words have a lower threshold for recognition. The time to recognise a word like 'speech' is dependent on its frequency of occurrence in the individual's lexicon. One complicating factor in this theory of word recognition is the existence of 'competitors'. For example, a word like 'speech' has 'competitors', words with similar phonological forms, such as 'speed' and 'species' and 'peach'. The threshold level for word recognition must not be reached until the competitors have been overruled by either phonological evidence or contextual evidence or both.
