1. Language policy and planning, language use in professional settings are part of applied linguistics.

2. Linguistics remains a core notion for applied linguistics.

3. Critical studies such as critical awareness, critical discourse analysis, critical pedagogy, and critical assessment have become one of the major emphases in the field of applied linguistics.

4. Applied linguistics is a subject.

5. The nature of applied linguistics is problem-based.

- 13. Differences in cultural expectations toward particular types of interpersonal interactions or discourse types can lead to significant misinterpretation.
- 14. The production of specific utterances begins by monitoring of the particular pragmatic purpose, content, speaker orientation, and appropriate speech acts in terms of contextual appropriacy and relevance.
- 15. Understanding the level of conceptualization provides a basis for understanding how speakers solve communication problems through the use of communication strategies.
- 16. Speakers often fail to correct their speech errors. This suggests that errors are picked up after formulation.
- 17. The grammar-translation method was mostly based on the use of phrase books and written dialogues.
- 18. The audiolingual approach was based on the idea that new language should be taught initially through reading and writing.
- 19. The grammar-translation method and the audiolingual approach both neglected the significant aspects of speaking as a skill.
