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- I. Supply a linguistics technical term according to the statement given: 30%
1. Words whose pronunciations suggest their meaning, e.g., *cock-a-doodle-doo*.
 2. A class of sounds characterized by a phonetic property or feature that pertains to all members of the set, e.g., the class of fricatives.
 3. The situation in which phones never occur in the same phonetic environment, e.g., [t] and [t^h] in English.
 4. The time between early childhood and puberty during which a child can acquire language easily, swiftly, and without external intervention.
 5. A word that does not have clear lexical meaning but has a grammatical function, e.g., prepositions.
 6. Bound grammatical morpheme that is affixed to a word according to rules of syntax, e.g., regular plural suffix -s/-es.
 7. Word composed of the initials of several words, e.g., UNESCO.
 8. The semantic relationship between the verb and the noun phrases of a sentence, such as agent, theme, instrument.
 9. Two or more words that are identical except for one phoneme that occurs in the same position in each word, e.g., sit / set.
 10. A variety of language whose grammar differs in systematic ways from other varieties in terms of lexical, phonological, syntactic, or semantic differences.

- III. Give a shorthand notation (formula) to illustrate the phonological rules (P-rules) involved in the pronunciation of the word *beam*. 10%
- IV. Give a tree diagram to show the syntactic structure of the sentence *John knows what I mean*. 10%
