In 1934, a chemist named Wallace Carothers produced in a laboratory a substance that could be stretched into long, smooth strands. It was far more elastic than silk. Du Pont, the company that employed Carothers, kept the discovery secret while researching a way to use the substance in fabric. In 1940, Du Pont's new fabric went on sale throughout the Unite States in the form of women's hosiery. The fabric was named "nylon." In the first year, 64 million pairs of nylon stockings were sold.

Since then, many things – such as tires, carpets, parachutes, and various clothing items – have been made from nylon. Nylon is also used for fishing lines, bristles for brushes, and machine parts in factories. Surgeons use nylon thread to sew up wounds.

Nylon was the first synthetic fabric thought to be superior to natural fabrics. It was hailed as a great discovery. Unfortunately, the name of Wallace Carothers is almost unknown. The name most people remember when they think of nylon is Du Pont. Carothers might have been as famous as Eli Whitney and Thomas Edison.
