- Pride, the most serious among the seven deadly sins, is featured in some works in the English literary canon. Choose two works before the year 1798 and elaborate on the two works' idea of pride. (15 points)
- Shakespeare's works are often regarded as universal in the sense that they deal with some issues from a certain perspective still relevant to our time.

  Discuss and explain how certain work/works by Shakespeare manifests the universality as described. (15 points)
- What is a satire? Define the term and explain how Jonathan Swift's Gulliver's Travels is a satire. (10 points)
- How are the sixteenth-century English sonnets different from the seventeenth-century English metaphysical poetry? Explain by comparing one sonnet and one metaphysical poem. (10 points)
- How do you define English Romanticism? Please start with its sources of influence, philosophical and political significance, tenets of language, poetic diction, and themes. Please support your arguments with analyses of some examples from the major poets. (15 points)

- What were the major concerns in the Victorian period, and how were they reflected in the Victorian prose, poetry and fiction? Please cite and analyze at least two examples from each genre. (15 points)
- How did Robert Browning influence Ezra Pound and how did Pound influence W. B. Yeats and T. S. Eliot? This is a question about literary influences, legacies and heritage. (10 points)
- What happened to the English poetry, in terms of metrics, prosody, rhyming forms, themes, or concerns in the early twentieth century? That is, how did English poetry radically modernize itself around 1910-1922?

  (10 points)
