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1. Use life-cycle model to show how the Social Security pension system can reduce annual consumption for some works that have strong preference for current versus future consumption. (10 分)

2. 請詳細說明下列敘述是否正確(僅回答正確或錯誤者不予給分)(40分)

- (1) Taxing hotel rooms and restaurant meals in a city with lots of tourism is an example of tax expenditures. (5 分)
- (2) The marginal social cost of producing another unit of a pure public good is zero, because pure public goods can only be collectively consumed. (5 分)
- (3) Suppose the marginal cost of a pure public good increase as more is purchased by a community. The Lindahl equilibrium will result in a budget surplus at the efficient annual output of the pure public good. (10 分)
- (4) The marginal external benefit of the sale of smoke detectors in a city declines with annual output. At the current competitive equilibrium level of output per year, the marginal external benefit is \$5 per unit of output. To achieve efficiency, a corrective subsidy of more than \$5 per unit of output is required. (10 分)
- (5) Because an income tax distorts the saving decision and a personal consumption tax does not, one can conclude that a personal consumption tax is preferable. (10 分)
- 3. An economist claimed: "Although the lump-sum principle analysis tells us that a private health insurance market could be more efficient, government should intervene because of the problem of adverse selection." (17 分)
 - (1) Analyze *public* health insurance with the lump-sum principle model.(5 分)
 - (2) Analyze *private* health insurance in relation to adverse selection.(5 分)
 - (3) Do you agree the above statement?(7 分)
