In many large cities, bicycling is a making of a comeback as a form of transportation for commuters. Its increasing popularity is due to several factors. First, people are discovering that for short distances, riding a bicycle can be just as quick as driving a car, especially when the extra time needed to find *scarce* parking for cars is considered. Second, riding a bicycle provides an alternative to mass transit, which while convenient, is often overcrowded. And finally, as people become more health-conscious, riding a bicycle is seen not only as a practical way to get from place to place in the city, but also as an excellent form of exercise.

In Taipei, the city government is making an effort to encourage more people to ride bicycles rather than drive cars. More bicycle riders would mean better traffic conditions for those who do drive, as well as less air pollution. With this in mind, the city government has constructed bicycle lanes along some major roads. In addition, it has installed more bicycle racks to make it easier for people to securely park their bicycles.

The general trend toward greater use of bicycles, as well as the particular measures being undertaken by the Taipei city government, mean Taipei should be seeing more and more bicycle riders on its streets in the years to come.
